Symptoms

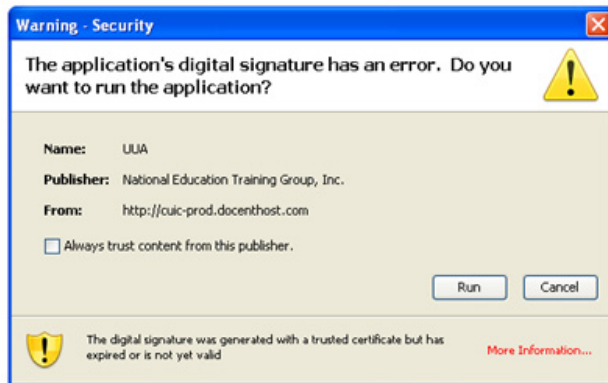
When launching an eLearning course, you receive up to three JAVA security warnings, regarding a digital signature or security certificate

Solution

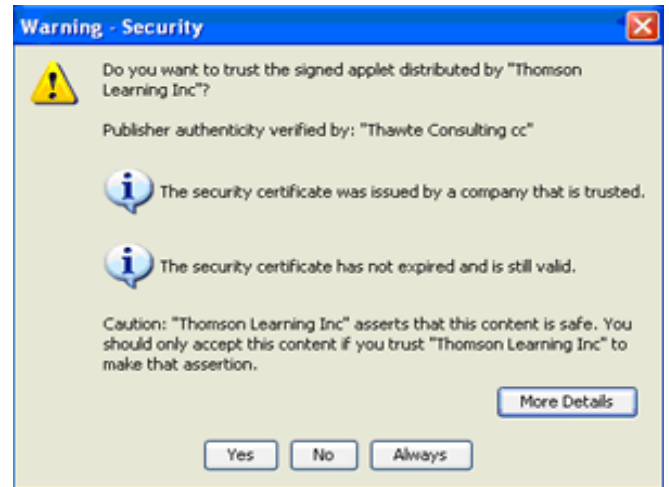
Sun JAVA software requires that you grant it authorization, in the form of a security warning, before it is able to run CUSOURCE eLearning courses. These warnings appear when launching many of our eLearning courses and are required for the course to function correctly.

The message appears as below:

Before selecting **Run** or **YES** on these Security warning windows, please ensure that the **Publisher:**, **From:**, and **Distributor** are from known sources.
